

## **DOCTOR TO BUY MIKE CARROZZO FARM FOR \$150,000**

Arrangements were completed yesterday for the sale of Superior farms, the 1,200 acre estate owned by the late Michael Carrozzo, Chicago union boss, in LaPorte county, Indiana, for \$150,000. The purchasers are Dr. Walter M. Behn and his wife, Frieda, of 652 McKinley street, Gary. Dr. Behn is a former Gary health commissioner.

Judge Robert S. Baker of Superior court of LaPorte county approved yesterday the sale of the personal property on the farms, including trucks, machinery, and 50 head of pure bred dairy cattle, to Dr. Behn and his wife by Mrs. Julie Carrozzo, widow of the union boss and administratrix of his estate. Sale of the real estate for \$120,000 is expected to be completed tomorrow.

Carrozzo died without leaving a will and his property, under Indiana law, is to be divided equally by his widow and two children, Michael, 14, and Carole, 11. Judge Baker also approved a settlement for \$20,000 of a \$45,000 claim for legal fees against the estate, submitted by the Chicago firm of Gottlieb & Schwartz.
